

Pallet Magazine Q½



The pallet magazine is designed for automatic stacking or destacking of one pallet at a time.

The Q½ pallet magazine is equipped with photocells that serve both as a safety feature and to activate the system, enabling it to automatically stack or destack pallets individually.

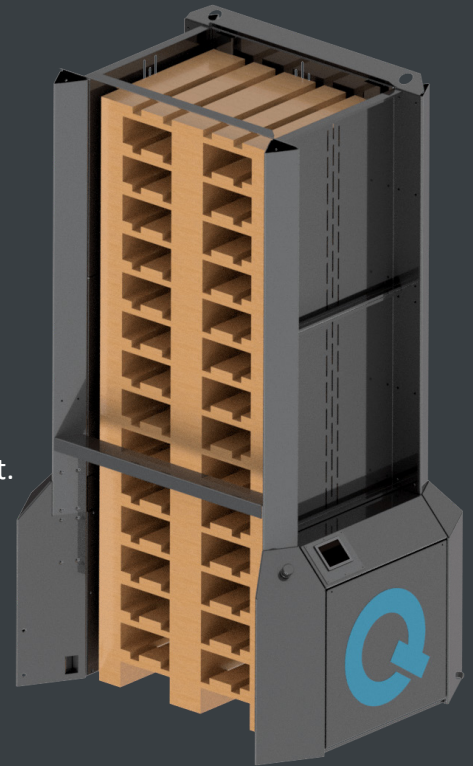
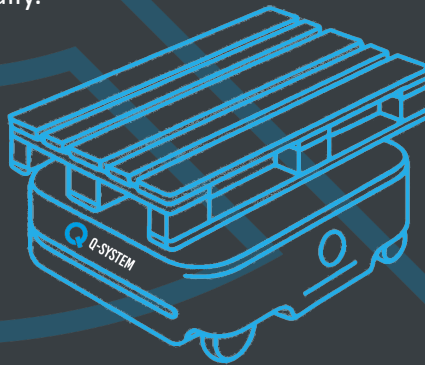
Destacking:

When used for destacking, a stack of up to 15 or 25 pallets is loaded into the pallet magazine using a forklift or pallet jack. The Q½ will then automatically release one pallet at a time.

Stacking:

When used for stacking, pallets are inserted into the Q½ one by one. The unit will automatically stack them up to 8, 15, or 25 pallets in height.

The control panel is user-friendly and allows for quick switching between stacking and destacking modes. Once selected, the process runs fully automatically.
