

Pallet Magazine Q1

Compatible with in-line pallet magazines - seamless integrates with AMRs, AGVs and automated production lines.



The pallet magazine is designed for automatic stacking or destacking of one pallet at a time.

The Q1 pallet magazine is equipped with photocells that serve both as a safety feature and to activate the system, enabling it to automatically stack or destack pallets individually.

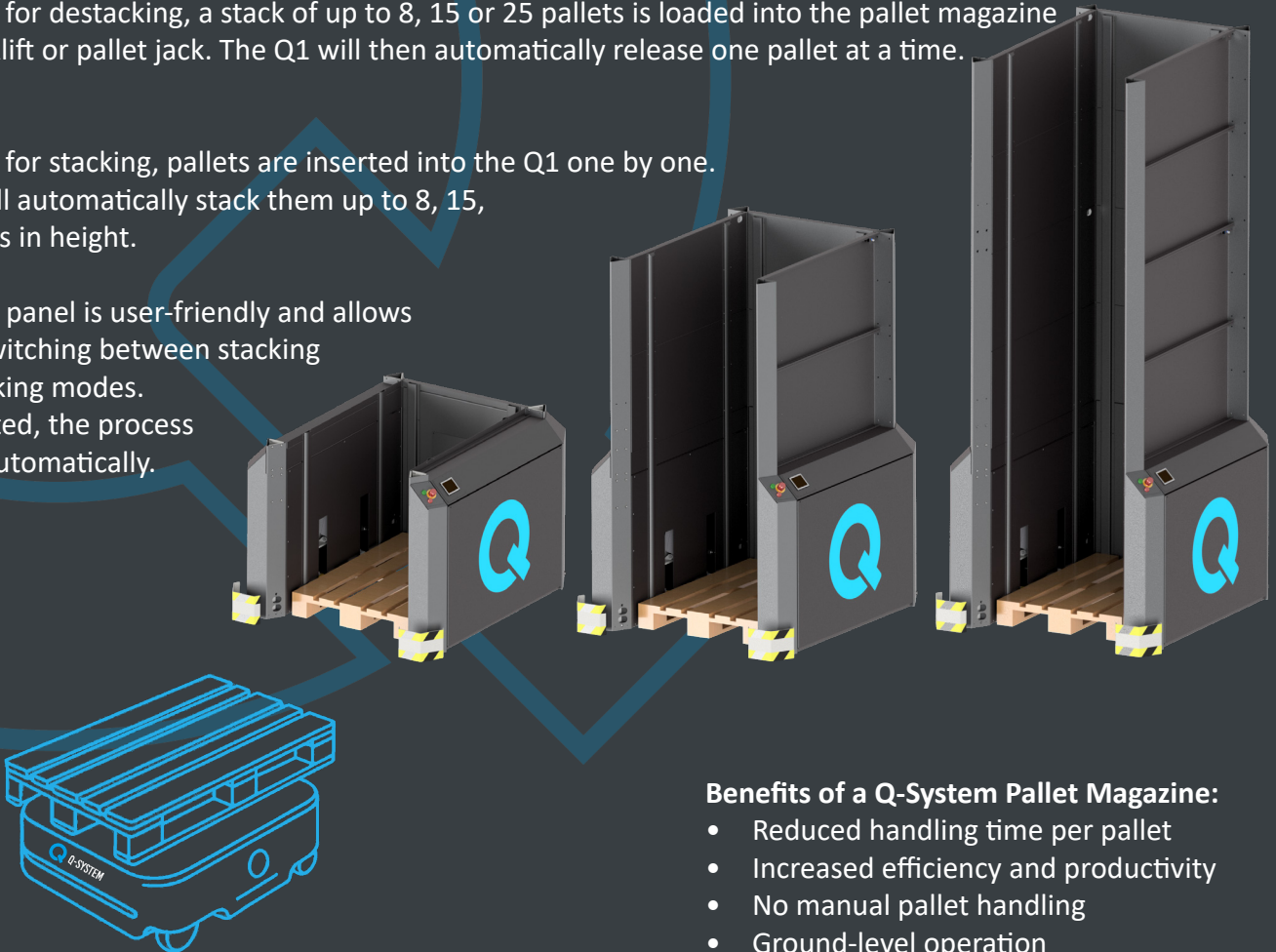
Destacking:

When used for destacking, a stack of up to 8, 15 or 25 pallets is loaded into the pallet magazine using a forklift or pallet jack. The Q1 will then automatically release one pallet at a time.

Stacking:

When used for stacking, pallets are inserted into the Q1 one by one. The unit will automatically stack them up to 8, 15, or 25 pallets in height.

The control panel is user-friendly and allows for quick switching between stacking and destacking modes. Once selected, the process runs fully automatically.
